Multnomah County is seeking a Program Communications Specialist (intern) to join the Multnomah County Animal Services division. You will assist in and/or graphic design, document management, multimedia projects and some social media.

Multnomah County Animal Services has been recognized as one of the top performing communities in the country for implementing innovative, progressive life-saving programs for shelter animals and creating a safe, livable community for people and animals. We are the only open door shelter in Portland and the primary agency responsible for lost pet care, animal abuse investigation and animal rescue in Multnomah County. We also offer dog and cat licensing, lost and found pet services, and animal adoptions.

### **Job Description:**

This position will involve a combination of graphic design, document management, multimedia projects and some social media.

Tasks will include implementing a new document management system and cataloging /organizing/updating documents. Some documents may need to be redesigned in InDesign. This position will adapt existing artwork to create new designs for products on our Cafepress store and create brief, simple videos of adoptable animals for the web. Additional duties may include creating memes for social media.
