Dear Mr Quintos:

We have reviewed your initiative petition paperwork, as to meeting the requirements to collect signatures, and have found it to be in order. Please use only the approved forms during signature collection.

The deadline to collect a minimum of 17,381 signatures from registered voters in Multnomah County is six months from the court decision of June 15, 2017. That six month deadline would be December 15, 2017.

However, for the initiative to be placed on the November 7, 2017 Special Election, Multnomah County Code requires the completed petition be turned in by close of business at 5:00 p.m., July 25, 2017. If the petition sheets are turned in after July 25, 2017, and there are sufficient signatures, the initiative question will be placed on the May 2018 Primary Election ballot.

Signature sheets must be numbered prior to submission.
