Multnomah County Road Maintenance is seeking 2 Engineer Technician 1 (intern) to join the Road Maintenance team. You will assist in and/or perform engineering technician duties such as drainage culvert inspections, field i-pad documentation, and other engineering technician support duties associated with road maintenance inspections.

The Multnomah County Road Maintenance maintains over 550 lane miles of roadway and over 1,500 storm system culverts throughout the County. The Road Maintenance team is 34 staff. The primary goal of the Road Maintenance team is to provide safe transportation facilities for the public (car, bike and pedestrian traffic), to protect the public investment by preserving the County right of way.

This position will have an emphasis in the following duties:

- Perform and/or assist in assessing County storm culverts in the field
- Importing and managing data in spreadsheets and databases
- Periodically preparing reports

Education and Experience:

We are looking for someone with major course work in engineering, GIS, construction management, or related field and possession of or ability to obtain, an appropriate and valid driver's license.
