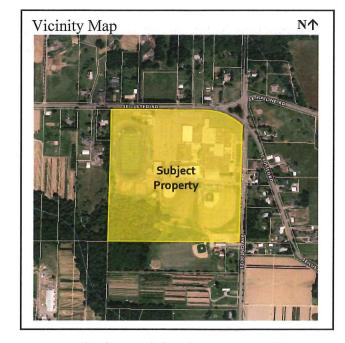

Applicant's proposal is a request for temporary permits for modular classrooms at Sam Barlow High School. The proposal includes five, two-classroom modular buildings that will serve the High School during 2018-19 school year, while major renovation and reconstruction project is underway. The temporary classrooms will be located west of existing school, in an area currently used for parking. Permanent changes to the school were recently approved in County Land Use Decision, case file T2-2017-9119.
