Position Description

This position is responsible for monitoring the activities and services delivered in adult care homes facilities. The monitor also assists the licenser in determining if licensing requirements are being met by Adult Care Home operators. Monitors conduct home visits and interview residents in adult care homes to determine if their health, welfare, and safety are adequately protected. Monitors also coach and teach operators and caregivers through one-on-one technical assistance to support providers in providing excellent care and to ensure their compliance with Multnomah County Administrative Rules. Monitors must thoroughly understand the applicable state laws (such as abuse reporting) and Multnomah County Administrative Rules in order to provide training/technical assistance to identify and document areas of non-compliance. Monitors serve as a liaison between County, community agencies and regulated businesses.

Job Duties

Most jobs generally consist of five to eight (5-8) major functions related directly to the purpose of the position. List functions in descending order. DO NOT list functions that take less than 5% of the time. Typically the top three to four (3-4) most critical functions summarize approximately 60-70% of the assigned work.
