Activity Ideas from August Retreat Youth Experience of Safety, Belonging, Bullying and Adult Support

<u>Activity 1</u>

Share youth experience information with respective constituents, leaders and staff

- Develop messaging including sense of urgency; balance of data & storytelling; student voice)
- Members and others deliver messages, advocate within own organizations
- Be active part of communication plan for SF2020 report

<u>Activity 2</u>

Develop and disseminate capacity and skill building supports for adults

(Teachers, School Staff, SUN providers and other youth devt staff)

- Ask youth what they want, what supports them, and what isn't helpful
- Research existing resources, tools and trainings
- Growth mindset training common language across schools and SUN providers
- Track SF2020 process learn what supports the work
- Offer trainings for school and SUN staff on intervening in bullying; and fostering conditions that make youth feel that they belong
- Specific tools/support/coaching for skills around interrupting racism
- Set foundation for change using data which supports culture

<u>Activity 3</u>

Provide safe places and support for youth

- Trauma informed services
- Specific structures and relationship building to provide safety
- Prioritize making SUN safe space to address urgent needs

<u>Activity 4</u>

Offer wraparound services based on survey results

<u>Activity 5</u>

Other SUN CS high schools use Reynolds surveys/replicate effort

• Important to form relationships and agreements and take political and reputational implications into account

<u>Activity 6</u> Increase understanding of youth experience

- Listening sessions true direct conversation with youth in panels regarding race
- Survey identified populations: social and emotional needs to prioritize services

<u>Activity 7</u>

Youth-led actions at sites

- Youth led site based justice research
- Youth led surfacing of building level specific action areas

<u>Activity 8</u>

Align measurement and use of survey data

- Integrate data from various school climate/health surveys
- One collaborative survey (school climate survey?) which would allow schools/SUN to work together for data collection.
