What is this Internship Project all about?:

Multnomah County recently adopted the Workforce Equity Strategic Plan, a plan designed to help create a workplace where everyone can reach their full potential. The plan aims to reach all employees, especially those who have been historically marginalized.

The Division of Assessment, Recording and Taxation (DART) is seeking qualified candidates for a temporary position to assist our Change Management Analyst with a variety of projects related to Workforce Equity and Employee Engagement. Projects may include helping to create a documented new employee/onboarding training curriculum for all new DART employees and helping establish the Welcome Wagon committee that will engage new employees as they begin their employment in DART.

What tasks will I be assigned?:

- Compile and create training materials for new employee/onboarding curriculum.
- Assist in preparing spreadsheets, general letters and other written material.
- Prepare presentations using various software programs, including PowerPoint and Google Slides.
- Attend and participate in staff meetings and trainings/workshops.
- Attend Division and Department planning meetings relating to Workforce Equity.
