#### **Position Description:**

This College to County Mentorship Program participant will support the Office of Equity and Inclusion by researching the County Health Departments history of equity related work over the past 20 years. Participants will conduct interviews with current and retired staff, search through library catalogs and internal documentation to document the history of within the health department. The research and documentation will be used to produce a workshop and online database.
