If a second public hearing is to be held, it will be before the County Hearings Officer Joe Turner.

If a second hearing is requested by any party, it will be held on **May 3, 2019**, at **9:00 am** or soon thereafter, in Room 103 at the Land Use Planning Division office located at 1600 SE 190th Avenue, Portland, OR 97233.

Proposal: Applicant is requesting a Variance to the street side yard and to the rear yard to allow

existing accessory buildings to remain in their present location in the Multiple Use Agriculture-20 (MUA-20) zone. In addition, the applicant is seeking approval of a Significant Environmental Concern for wildlife habitat permit to allow the existing six accessory buildings that have been constructed without review. An Accessory Use

Determination is required to authorize at least one of the structures.

<u>Public Participation and Hearing Process:</u> A copy of the application and all evidence submitted in support of the application is available for inspection, at no cost, at the Land Use Planning Division office during normal business hours. A staff report will be available for inspection 7 days prior to the hearing, also at no cost. Copies of all documents may be purchased at the rate of 30-cents per page. All interested parties may appear and testify or submit written comment on the proposal at or prior to the hearing. Comments should be directed toward approval criteria applicable to the request. The hearing procedure will follow the Hearing Officer's *Rules of Procedure* and will be explained at the hearing.

The Hearings Officer may announce a decision at the close of the hearing or on a later date, or the hearing may be continued to a time certain. Notice of the decision will be mailed to the applicant, any persons who submitted written comment, requested a decision in writing, or provided oral testimony at the hearing. A decision by the Hearings Officer may be appealed to the Land Use Board of Appeals by the applicant, the County, or other participants at the hearing. An explanation of the requirements for filing an appeal will be included in the notice of decision.

Failure to raise an issue before the close of the public record in sufficient detail to afford the County and all parties an opportunity to respond may preclude appeal on that issue to the Land Use Board of Appeals.


