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Proposal: The primary water supply for the City of Portland is the Bull Run Watershed. The water supply from the Bull Run watershed is disinfected and transported through three (3) Large diameter conduits by gravity flow to distribution reservoirs. The proposed project consists of replacing existing pipes and pipe supports (11) (with new pipe supports that are founded deeper, below scour depth) in the same location to improve the system for seismic and erosion deficiencies.
