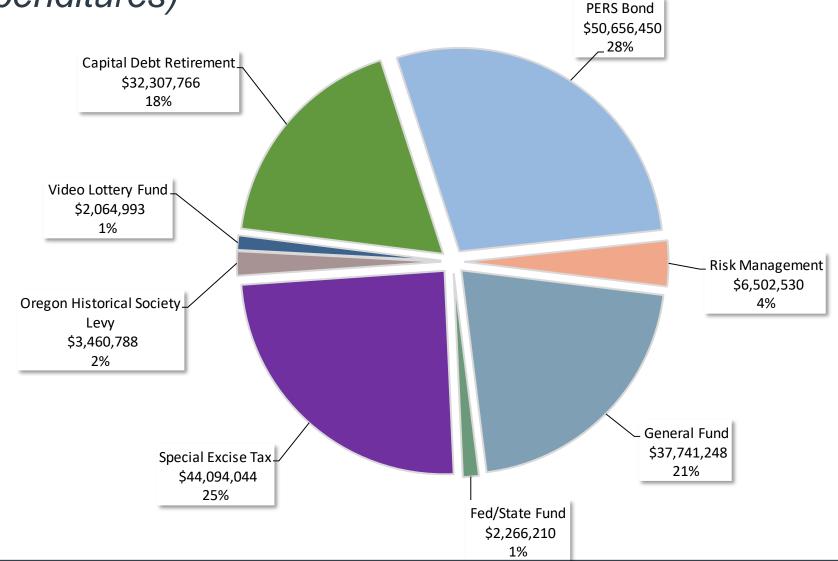

Total Budget by Fund - \$179,174,329 (Expenditures)





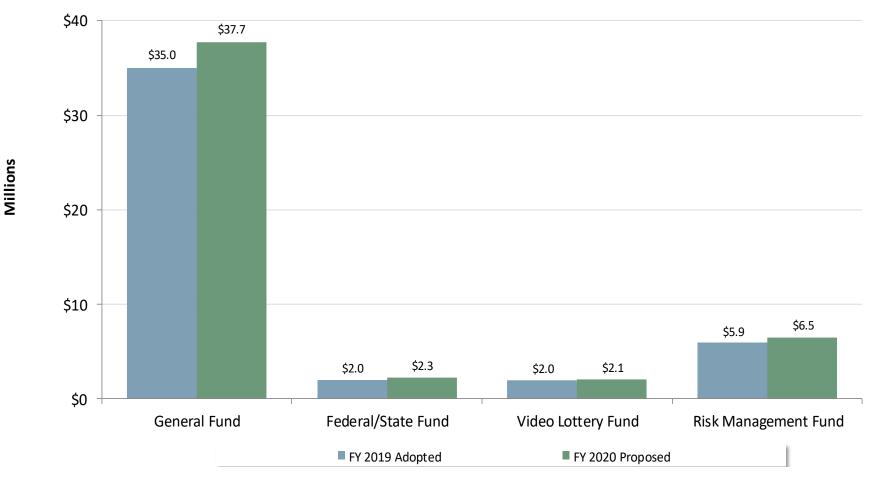

Non County Agencies & Corporate Funds -\$130.1 million (Expenditures)



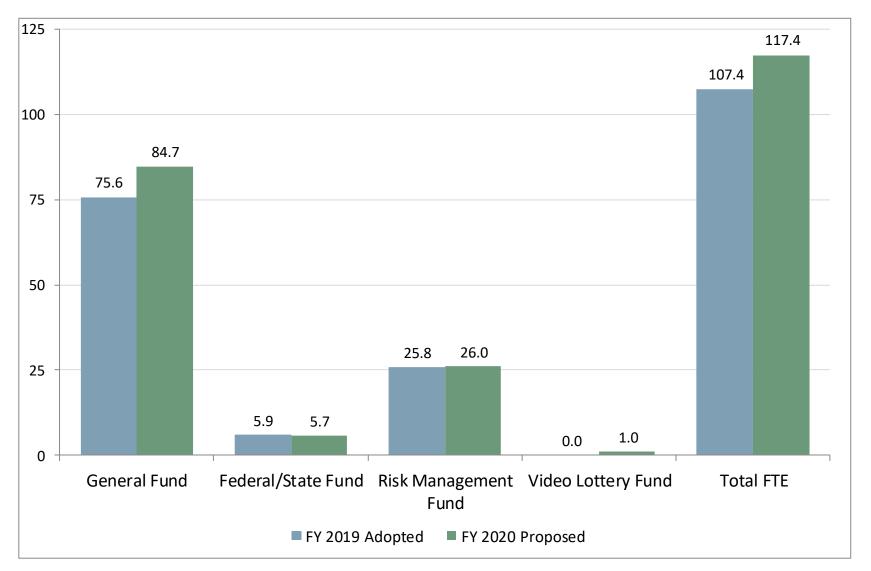
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Operating Budget by Fund - \$48.6 million *(Expenditures)*





FTE by Fund





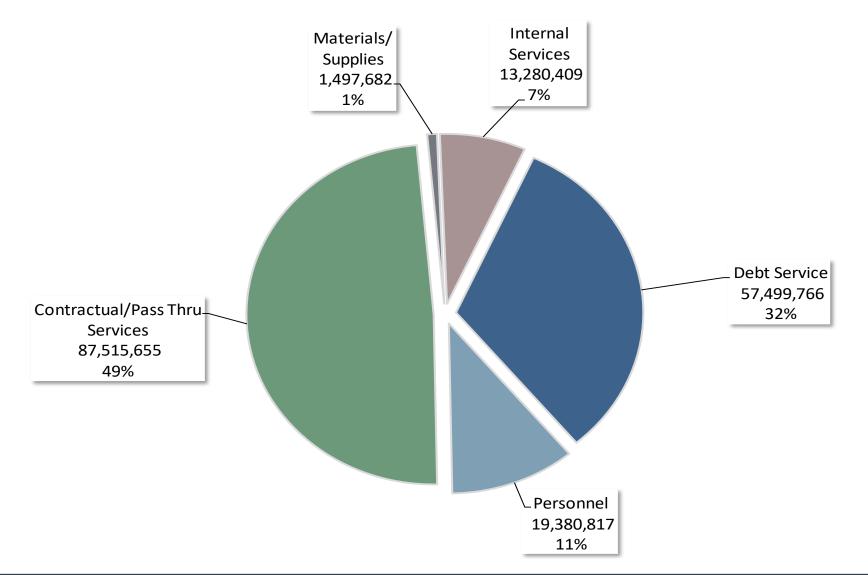
