Kevin – Good morning. In addition to the lighting proposed on the vault toilet, represented in Exhibit 11 and in our June 8<sup>th</sup> submission (item 8), the narrative references a "security" light in the parking area. It is not currently depicted in any drawings. This was referenced in case comments from citizens or the local sheriff desired it or it was otherwise determined as something that would be appropriate. There is no standard that requires lighting that I am aware of. The reference was included to keep our options open. The lighting standard merely states if you do put a light in that it needs to be dark skies compliant. We are committed to only using dark skies compliant lighting. I think that a condition of approval can ensure compliance with that standard.
