# **Gun Violence Reduction Strategy**

Reygan Cunningham, Senior Partner at The California Partnership for Safe Communities, and David Muhammed, Executive Director of the National Institute for Criminal Justice Reform (NICJR), presented *What Works to Reduce Gun Violence: Overview of National Research Evidence and Best Practice.* 

The presentation included information on why CPSC and NICJR are working with Portland and their observations so far, framing the problem, the research, the strategy, best practice, the Oakland Case Study, problem analysis, community of support, the impact in Oakland, system changes, and information about the evaluation.

Some highlighted points include:

- Activities must impact the goals directly.
- Social networks bring risk.
  - The terms gang/crew/group are interchangeable. It comes down to who you hang out with.
- Before the analysis was done in Oakland, the assumption was gun violence was driven by juveniles.
