LEAD IN POTTERY

The glaze paint in some Mexican pottery may contain lead — a poisonous metal that can harm people if it enters the body.

WHO IS AT RISK?

Young children and pregnant women are most at risk of lead poisoning because it can hurt normal brain development.





WHAT CAN YOU DO ABOUT IT?

- Test your pottery for lead by calling the Leadline at 503-988-4000 for options.
- Avoid using pottery containing lead for cooking and serving.
- Test your family for lead. Ask your doctor for a blood lead test.
