Budget Discussion Program 10012A

- \$1,959,060 (General Fund with 2% reduction)
- Includes \$310,000 grant which supports staff (Low/Moderate Risk)
- Includes 9 FTE
- Total \$2,998,560 Program Offer 10012A
 - Program Offer 10012A will be comprised of \$1,959,060 in general fund money and \$1,039,500 total grant funding



Program 10012B – Emergency Management Training position


1 FTE - Training/Exercise/ Data Mart

1.0 Total FTE @ \$125,000




General Fund Budget Comparison






Federal Grant Budget Comparison
