Dear Sarah Yarjani Muranovic;

This letter provides the Election Director's certification of the attached ballot title and explanatory statement as prescribed by a court order dated June 1, 2020, following the ballot title challenge related to MultCoInit-08.

We have reviewed your initiative petition paperwork, as to meeting the requirements to collect signatures, and have found it to be in order and to include the certified ballot title as necessary. Please use only the approved forms during signature collection. You must use the same paper color for all petition sheets. **This is approval for circulation of the SEL 369 with the union print logo.** 

The deadline to collect a minimum of 22,686 signatures from registered voters in Multnomah County is December 3, 2020, which is six months from the date of the Election Director's ballot title certification (June 3, 2020).

If the petition is turned in with sufficient valid signatures by July 6, 2020, the initiative will be placed on the November 2020 General Election ballot. Otherwise, if the petition is turned in with sufficient signatures by December 2, 2020, it will be placed on the May 2021 Special Election ballot.

Signature sheets must be numbered prior to submission.
