Process: Call ahead to Providence location to schedule an appointment
Eligibility: Anyone with COVID-19 related symptoms

OHSU

- North Testing Site: 2060 N. Marine Dr, Portland, OR 97217
- Process: Testing is available Monday-Saturday, 9 A.M. to 4 p.m.
- Eligibility: Must have developed respiratory symptoms within the past 14 days

Walgreens

- Process: Walgreens is offering drive-thru COVID-19 testing services
- Eligibility: Must complete online screening form at Walgreens.com/covid19/testing, results will determine eligibility

Pharmacy

- ► Process: Call 971-288-7687 for free prescription delivery service
- Availability: Monday-Friday, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Eligibility: Folks who are age 65 or older, individuals who are disabled, or otherwise unable to pick up their medication
