

- Original Construction office for the City
 - Turned community center, school, then City Hall
 - Several remodels and additions over the decades
- Sold for redevelopment
 - Add housing and value to the City
 - 173 units
 - 10,000 sq. ft. of retail

New Building

- Once in a lifetime opportunity
- Sets the stage for redevelopment (the look) branding
- Serve the community and surrounding areas
 - Public first design
 - Fill need gaps
 - No additional land off the tax roll
 - Improve the park
 - Future EMCTC Meeting ?




Process

 - Open House cancelled due to COVID, but still reached over 30 firms
 - Bid Notice large page ad business tribune, plus in targeted publications
 - Direct notice Kirby 108 firms, Wood Village
 118 firms






Cost

- Hard construction costs: \$4,456,039
 - a~\$370,000 in 97060 zip code
 - \$1,043,289 from the close in Portland Metro area
 - 23% of the project award to close-in area firms
- Total GMP: \$6,000,000


