This measure renews current local option taxes. In 2016 voters approved a five-year local option levy of \$.05 per \$1,000 assessed property value to support the Oregon Historical Society (OHS). Renewal of this levy will continue support to the OHS's museum, library, educational programs, and fund the following without increasing taxes: • Educational programs; • Free admission to school groups and Multnomah County residents; • Preservation of important Oregon treasures and artifacts; • Support four County historical societies: Fairview-Rockwood-Wilkes Historical Society, Troutdale Historical Society, and Crown Point Country Historical Society, and Crown Point Country Historical Society; • OHS will continue to build on its efforts to provide exhibits and services that reflect the diverse histories of our region, and engage all parts of our county. Levy continues rate of \$.05 per \$1,000 assessed property value, and replaces the 2016 levy. A home assessed at \$200,000 pays \$10 a year. An independent citizen oversight committee will review expenditures to verify that funds are used as approved by voters. Annual audits will be conducted and made public.
