SUBJECT: 2020-2040 Troutdale Town Center Plan

Thank you for the opportunity to present to EMCTC about Troutdale's comprehensive update to its Town Center Plan. The presentation will focus on transportation and mobility topics which are of particular interest to EMCTC. Attached to this memo include excerpts from the Plan. Troutdale City Council is working through final edits to the plan, which is expected to be adopted on May 11, 2021. The transportation and mobility sections are not expected to be changed from the draft that is presented to you.

Of particular interest for the Committee will be the opportunity corridors where the City will intend to focus future transportation needs and projects to help fulfill the Town Center Vision. Of the eight corridors, five of them are County-owned facilities. Several opportunity sites on adjacent properties may also include future transportation projects of interest.

It is anticipated that Troutdale will update other long-range planning documents to account for new/expanded projects showcased in the plan, which will also influence potential future funding prioritization for the City, particularly with any federal, state, or regional funding opportunities. The City looks forward to working with our EMCTC partners and neighboring jurisdictions as we continue to make long-term quality of life improvements for East County.
