

**BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

PROCLAMATION NO. 2021-033**

Declaring the Week of May 16 through May 22, 2021 as “**National Public Works Week**” and recognizing the contributions of all Multnomah County Public Works Employees.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. Public works infrastructure, facilities, and services are of vital importance to the health, safety and well-being of the citizens of Multnomah County;
- b. The public works infrastructure, facilities, and services could not be provided without the dedicated efforts of public works professionals, including engineers, surveyors, technicians, planners, and operations and maintenance staff and administrators;
- c. County public works professionals design, build, operate, and maintain the transportation system, stormwater infrastructure, sewage, fleet, public buildings and facilities that are vital to the people and communities of Multnomah County; and
- d. Understanding the role that public infrastructure plays in protecting the environment, improving public health and safety, contributing to the economic vitality, and enhancing the quality of life of the community is in the interest of the citizens of Multnomah County.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Proclaims:

The week of May 16 through 22, 2021 as "NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK," and calls upon the citizens of this community to recognize the contributions that all public works employees make every day to our health, safety, comfort, and economic prosperity.


