Amee McFee - 4D	Cody, Amee and Tony: Have one staff member who is doing vaccine outreach and engagement. Have a station set up where folks can sign up to get the vaccine (MLK). All meetings running smoothly. Had two people report that they may have COVID, they followed the guidelines and all were good. Stepped the protocols up to increase masking for those not vaccinated. Questionnaire asking anyone who comes into the center if they are interested in vaccination. 4D needs masks; they received masks that are too small. Cotton black. We also have two male mentor positions available for MLK and Smit center. Qualifications to apply: below (the age of population we serve) the age 35, identifies as a person being in recovery. Dana Boddy – Alano Club	All meetings have stayed at 25% capacity. Some people are in person, some remote. Wanting to grow the paper connect program at Alano Club. Open to meeting with folks to create partnerships. 4 full time mentors with no restrictions with age, or geography. Danielle Allison - Cascadia	MAT program. Hosting a vaccine clinic at Garlington Center. No other updates	
Christina Anderson - VOA	Continuing to operate. Men's res and women's res both have openings. Openings in all four houses. The Victory house is in quarantine because they had a positive covid case. After Monday, quarantine will be over.	
Jocelyn Di Priest – CRC Allied	No PPE needs. Keeping things as is but talking about the return of small closed groups.	

Eric Martin – MHACBO/ ACCBO/MAPS	Grant funding for Outreach specialists expired. 4D may have picked up a similar grant with a position doing outreach into recovery homes. The DOJ and OHA are looking at adding traditional health workers CDC, QMHP as individuals authorized to do vaccinations. Could MAT programs also deliver vaccines? Yes, house in Corvallis closed permanently; they were a youth treatment program. 309 posting on the ACCBO employment website.
Nick Guerrero – Raphael House	Recovery mentor back at Gateway Center. No PPE needs at this time
Mike McGowan – De Paul	Couple of bed in boys youth facility available, downtown is full due to quarantine. Monthly vaccinations working well. Applying to be a pandemic provider so they can provide vaccines.
OCE	Nothing to report at this time. Measure 110 reviewing proposals for funding until the end of June. 115 proposals, 8.9 million dollars left/. The OCE will have authority in the next budget cycle. Awardees may know by next week or the following.
Barb Seater - Lifeworks NW	Mountain dale Recovery Center is on pause, suspending operations. Could not hire enough staff to cover shifts. Had 7 women who were placed in supportive housing programs and were able to discharge to intensive outpatient. Facility 10 bed capacity 8-12 weeks. Project network doing okay but mainly topped out. Good with PPE
