Executive Summary

The Juvenile Services Division (JSD) works closely with the County's Facilities and Property Management (FPM) Division to ensure the Juvenile Justice Complex is properly and safely maintained. This program offer supports the department's one time only request for funding to refurbish one pod within the detention center.

Program Summary

Since it was built in 1994-95 there has not been any real attention or upgrades made to JSD's juvenile detention facility. As JSD continues to promote positive youth development and trauma informed practices, it is important that the physical environment be conducive to positive growth and healing, as well as safety and security. This offer will supplement funding in FPM's Capital Improvement Plan to refurbish one pod in FY2022.

Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC) youth are disproportionately represented in the juvenile justice system and data shows BIPOC communities are disproportionately negatively impacted by COVID-19. Improving the physical conditions in detention will positively impact BIPOC youth who need to come to the Juvenile Justice Complex.
